

Door-to-Door



A simple way to remind the school to focus on kindness is by creating meaningful hallway decorations promoting it--starting with your own classroom door!

First: The goal is to create a decoration for your classroom door that spreads positivity and kindness. Make the design and completion a team project for your class. So, take time to work together to brainstorm.

Second: Set time aside to complete the door. Divide up the work with the students so everyone is involved in some way. If you don't have class time to do it, you could have students cut out the decorations for homework, then have some students help you before or after school

Third: If necessary at your school, be sure to secure administrative approval before you start. In talking with admin, you might even be able to make this a school-wide activity for all teachers to participate in!

Fourth: This would make a good start-of-the-year activity to start building teamwork and setting a positive tone right from the beginning.
