Instill kindness in your institution by starting a student group dedicated to volunteerism and spreading positivity.

First: Follow the school's requirements for starting a new student organization. Make sure all administrators and school board are okay with the group.

Second: Decide who will be the staff advisor. Then, work out expectations for the organization. These could be formal in the shape of bylaws or simply an organizational outline that establishes when meetings will be held, grade and behavior requirements for students to remain in the organization, and major goals for the group.

Third: Advertise your organization, then establish a introductory meeting. At this meeting, share your expectations created with those in attendance.

Fourth: Have regular meetings to share opportunities and results of activities.

Fifth: Have a celebratory event at the end of the year to showcase all your successes!
