Be kind to the environment by starting a recycling program at your institution.

First: Contact your town's local recycling center to see what their requirements are for you to begin collecting donations. They will be able to tell you days and times they can help with pick up, what materials they accept, and help provide you with the bins necessary.

Second: Communicate to all staff and students the importance of recycling and how your program is going to work based on those local requirements.

Third: Find staff or students to help with collecting recyclables. This could be a volunteer organization, an environmental club, or anyone else who wants to help the school and the environment.

Fourth: Make sure bins are put in easily-accessible locations! Think of putting them in places like copy rooms and the cafeteria as well where there is often high-output of recyclable materials.

Take it a step further: Apply for a Random Act grant to offset the cost of supplies!
