First: Compile a list of positive quotes and encouraging phrases. You can find these all over online, but you can make up your own, too!

Second: Work with a group of friends to come up with designs to go along with these messages.

Third: Bring your designs to a school administrator, then get their permission to chalk your designs on a sidewalk near the school entrance. Be sure they are ok with the sidewalk chalk you want to use and ask them exactly which area of the sidewalk you can use. If the sidewalk isn't an option, you might be able to use the parking lot. Also, be sure to ask them what date you can do it. A great option would be the first day back to school or the last day of school.

Fourth: Then, have fun decorating based on what the administrator allows! Maybe you can regularly chalk new messages, too! Just make sure you get permission!

Take it a step further: Work with an adult to apply for a Random Act grant to offset the cost of supplies so you can chalk more often!
